NABET-CWA and NBC Universal negotiators met again last week in New York City to continue negotiations for a successor to the Master Agreement, which expired eleven months ago on March 31, 2009.

During this series of meetings, conducted both with full committee and sub-committee exchanges, the parties discussed a number of open and still unresolved issues. On Thursday, February 25, 2010, the Union was presented with a modified version of the Company's Comprehensive Package, originally presented on January 12, 2010.

The Company's modified Comprehensive Package, containing a number of changes, as well as subsequent discussions between the parties, led to tentative agreements on several issues and moved the Union and the Company closer on some other issues. The parties still have not reached common ground on issues relating to Seniority/Layoff, Content Producers/Digital Journalists, wages and overall term of agreement

The parties have scheduled future meeting dates in mid-March.

In the meantime, members are reminded to ignore all rumors and contact your Local Union Office with any questions or concerns.
