

INSTRUCTIONS

The attached petition must be used to nominate candidates for the office of Regional Vice President.

Petitions, to be valid, require the signatures of not less than fifty (50) members in good standing in the Region, as stipulated in Section 7.2B of the NABET-CWA Sector By-Laws. For purposes of these nominating procedures, those active members who have paid their required financial obligations, pursuant to Section 2.4B of the Sector By-Laws, through May 4, 2018 shall be considered to be in good standing.

At least one of the nominating petitions for each candidate requires the signature of the candidate indicating his or her acceptance of the nomination. All candidates must have been active members in good standing in Region Three for at least three (3) years immediately prior to nomination.

Petitions with original signatures (copies will not be accepted) must be received at the NABET-CWA Sector Office at 501 Third Street NW - 6th Floor, Washington, DC 20001 on or before 5:00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time, April 13, 2018. Once a member has submitted a valid nominating petition his or her name shall be placed on the ballot, unless the candidate notifies the Sector Office in writing by April 23, 2018, that he or she desires to withdraw as a candidate.

If you wish to have literature (text only) included with the ballot, that material should be included with this petition. Literature cannot exceed one side of an 8-1/2" by 11" sheet of paper.

Ballots shall be prepared and mailed to the last known home address of each member in good standing on May 4, 2018.

Ballots must reach the post office by 10:00 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, Monday, June 4, 2018, and will be counted that day.

All candidates shall be entitled to designate one observer to be present at any or all phases of the ballot tabulation procedure. The Sector Office must be notified in writing by the candidate who the observer (if any) is to be.
